**STATEMENT OF PURPOSE**

Greenock Elementary School is committed to providing a quality education for every child in the school. When schools and parents form strong partnerships, all children's potential for academic success improves significantly.

The School will include parents in all aspects of the Greenock Title I program, following all requirements of the Title I regulations. The responsibility and accountability, for implementing the Greenock parent involvement procedures, will be shared with the District Title I office, the school, parents, and community.

Activities, meetings, and methods of communication shall be planned and implemented, using meaningful consultation with parents of the Title I children.

The Greenock Title I Parent Involvement procedures will be developed with help from and distributed to Title I parents in Greenock School. These procedures will be incorporated into the Elizabeth Forward School District Title I Program.

**COMPONENTS OF THE PROCEDURE**

Greenock Title I parents will give input and be involved in the development of the Title I Program and will be a part of the school review and school improvement procedures.

Greenock's Parent Involvement Program will build the school's capacity for strong parent participation. It will provide consultation and support to Title I parents.

Greenock parents will participate in an annual evaluation, to measure the effectiveness of the procedures of the Title I program and the parent involvement program.

The Title I Reading specialist will work closely with the principal, teachers, and parents of Greenock School to provide a program that coordinates with the special needs of the school.

**SCHOOL SUPPORT PROCEDURES**

Greenock Staff and District Title I Staff will work jointly to ensure effective involvement of parents. They will support partnerships among schools, parents and the community to improve student achievement. Parents will receive a copy of the School Parent

Involvement Policy. Annual meetings with flexible times and locations will be held. Information, discussions, and suggestions for home-school connections will be provided during parent meetings. Conferences with the Title I teacher are available on Parent-Teacher Conference Day or on any other prescheduled date. Annual Parent/School Compact review will be conducted. A description of the reading curriculum in use at the school will be provided during Open House or upon request. Regular reports of student progress will be sent to the home. Ongoing information about Title I policies, procedures, and student studies will be communicated to parents through a monthly Title I newsletter. The Elizabeth Forward website, which includes a section for Title I information, is also accessible to parents. Fliers are sent home throughout the school year to keep parents updated of the happenings in the Title I program. The school district offers technology classes and the Title I program offers meetings or “Family Fun Nights” which provide opportunities for parents to learn about academic activities and learning games for their children. Parents will be provided with access to Pennsylvania Academic Standards. Student progress with regard to curriculum and state standards will be discussed during parent conferences. School staff and parents will work together to improve student achievement.
