

Workplace Safety Committee Minutes

New Business

Randal Sydeski announced that the finger printing process for obtaining clearances has changed. There are fewer site locations and the timeline for scheduling appointments is much longer. He is making sure the district remains compliant with the required paperwork on all employees and new hires.

The committee approved two revisions to the existing schedule: February meeting will take place on the 5th and Mt Vernon report is changed to March 5th.

Accident Review

Water leaks occur in several places, most notably in the sixth grade hallway onto the floor. Outside railings are loose due to crumbling cement. The full report is on file with maintenance department.
